Instructions/Note :

1. (SC-Scheduled Caste, ST-Scheduled Tribe, OBC-Other Backward Class, PwD-Persons with Disability, UR- Unreserved)
2. Age relaxation up to 5(five) years for SC/ST and 3(three) years for OBC candidates. Applicants claiming age relaxation have to produce attested copy of caste certificate from the appropriate authorities.
3. In case of OBC, the caste certificate, interalia must specify that the candidate does not belong to 'Creamy Layer'. Form of certificate to be produced by other backward classes applying for appointment to posts under the Government of India as per DOP & T OM.No. 36033/28/94 dated 02/07/1997(Format enclosed at Appendix-II)
4. Ex-serviceman candidates should forward undertaking as per GOI/DOP & T OM/36034/29/Estts/Sct dated 03 Apr 1991. Vacancies are reserved for Ex-Servicemen within the total vacancies for SC/ST/OBC and 10% in Group 'C' posts. Age relaxation for Ex-Servicemen as per prescribed Government of India Rules. Benefit of age relaxation is to be claimed only once by ex-serviceman.

5. Eligible candidates working in Central Government/State Government etc. must submit their applications through proper channel alongwith a No Objection Certificate from his present employer.
6. Applications must be sent by **ordinary post** only.
7. The envelope containing the application should be clearly superscribed in **BOLD capitals** with the name of the post applied for and reservation category viz. SC/ST/OBC/UR/PH/Ex -Servicemen as applicable as follows :-

8. Separate application is to be sent for each post.
9. Number of vacancies are subject to change at the discretion of Competent Authority without intimation and without assigning any reason thereof, at any time during the course of recruitment.
10. Applications without full details in the given specimen and without 02 self addressed envelopes, 02 photographs, signature, attested certificates and those not conforming to required specification will be rejected summarily.
11. The department shall not be responsible for postal delays/loss.
12. If the number of applications received in response to advertisement is large and it may not be convenient or possible for the department to test/interview all the candidates. The department may restrict the number of candidates called for test/interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of merit in the basic qualification prescribed in the advertisement.
13. Decision of the Appointing authority would be considered final.
